Lutheran Summer Camp is a ministry of the Lutheran Council of Anchorage. The Lutheran Council leases Victory Bible Camp for a week of summer camping and community in the name of Jesus Christ. A portion of the cost incurred in this camping ministry is borne by the Lutheran Council and its members.

A typical camp day includes a morning of study and activity centered around the stories of God's grace and justice in the whole of creation. Craft activities, environmental and Bible studies all center around a common theme of God's work in the world, in the community, and in individuals.

Afternoons are spent in recreation and relaxation. Evenings are filled with games designed for the building up of this intentional community in Christ. Each

evening closes with a campfire in which the day's activities and events are rediscovered and brought to a close. After a snack, it's time to rest in preparation for another full day.

The staff of Lutheran Summer Camp is made up of high school, college, and adult volunteers (including a nurse) who donate their week to the care of their younger brothers and sisters in Christ. The size of the camp is strictly limited by the adult and pastoral participation so that the appropriate ratios may be maintained. Staff members are chosen based on their gifts and skills for working with young people. Applications are available for interested persons. Camp Programs:

Alpine Camp:... entering grades 3-6... \$325

Located above Index Lake, this "conference camp" facility includes heated cabins for 6-10 youth/counselor groups. The lake includes a waterfront with canoes, "funyaks," swimming, "the blob," and a power boat for "banana boat" rides. Hot showers and filling meals are a short walk away.

Koinonia Camp:... entering grades 7-9.. \$325

This Christian community will meet and live in retreat houses just down the road from Alpine Camp. This is a special place to be together as God's people. Afternoons allow roaming of the waterfront, the game room, and horseback rides.

General Information:

A telephone for campers (pay phone) may be used when supervised by a counselor. Phone calls home will not be allowed after 7pm. All calls must be collect or with a phone calling card. To contact your camper in an emergency, call Victory Bible Camp at 907-745-4203

Victory Bible Camp is located at milepost 95 on the Glenn Highway (near Matanuska Glacier). The camp is independently owned and operated. It's been affectionately used for many years by Lutherans of all ages.

Lutheran Community Camp will be held the weekend immediately preceding camp this year (August 5th-7th) at Birchwood Camp.

Please check with your congregation as most offer scholarships for a portion of the registration fees. If you are expecting congregational scholarship money, please note this on your child's form.

All camp registration fees and forms, including the medical release, must be received by July 18th.

Remember that we purchase food and recruit staff based on the number of registered campers. Last-minute cancellations and no-shows cost as much as a camper in attendance. Thus, \$100 of camp tuition is non-refundable. **No refunds** will be issued for cancellations in the seven days before camp begins.

What to Bring:

Sleeping Bag, • Flashlight • Raingear • Towel
Washcloth, soap, shampoo, and toiletries
Warm jacket • Swimsuit (no 2-piece suits allowed)
Bible • Clean clothes • Change of Shoes • Pillow
Insect repellent • Extra towel for swimming

What Not To Bring:

ANY electronic device (except watch or camera)
Balloons • Extra Food • Knives
Any other naughty items you know you shouldn't be bringing

Money:

You may bring some money for additional expenses

- Snack Shack (candy, soda, ice cream, etc)
- T-shirts, Sweatshirts, and Gift Items (\$7 - \$20 per item)
- Horseback rides (Alpine and Koinonia \$15; Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday)

Make checks for Snack Shack payable to Victory Bible Camp

Money will be turned in to counselors upon arrival. It will be held at the store so campers do not have to worry about loss. Unused funds will be returned at the end of the week.
